Proper Disposal of Waste to Prevent the Spread the Novel Coronavirus

Please pay extra attention when you dispose of any materials which had physical contact with people such as used masks, soiled tissue paper from blowing your nose, or diapers.



- Please follow rules below.

- Put them in the plastic bag and seal it first, then put in the designated prepaid garbage bag and dispose with other waste.
- Do not touch the waste which is put out by other people who are infected with the virus (wear gloves).
- After disposing of waste, wash your hands. (Thoroughly with soap or alcohol sanitizer)

During your home treatment period, you can dispose of recyclables such as cans, bottles, PET bottles, plastic containers and packaging together with household waste. You are not required to sort them because there is a possibility that droplets on those items may spread the virus.

After recovering and testing negative, we ask for your kind cooperation in sorting recyclables.
