

Would you like to put your language skills and experiences to use while getting involved in Sendai?

We are looking for foreign residents(international students, researchers, and accompanying family members) who want to take part in community activities and make friends with people in Sendai!

Recommended for people who want to...

...introduce games and culture from your home country at elementary schools /
interact with junior high school students in English / join walking tours /
participate in local festivals and events / test hands-on tourism activities /
work as an interpreter / do translation, and more.

Eligibility

(applicants must meet all of the following conditions):

- Must be a foreign national resident of Sendai City aged 16 or older.
- Must be either an international student, a researcher, a researcher's accompanying family member, or an international student's accompanying family member.
- Must have permission for "activities outside of your visa status".

Process after registration

- The secretariat recruits for both registrant and community activities.
- The secretariat selects suitable participants from the registered members.
- The secretariat contacts those chosen to join the activity.
- Participants take part in the activity.

Details of the activities

- Each activity lasts about 2 hours (some may involve multiple sessions in succession).
- For each activity, participants will receive a QUO card worth 3,500 yen.
- In some activities, you may bring small children with you(however, QUO cards are not provided for children).

Important Notes

- Even if you register, you may not always be able to take part in your preferred activity.
- Photos and videos of activities may be taken and used in Sendai City's publicity materials.
- Cancellations without notice or unexplained absences are not allowed.
- Personal information will be properly managed by the secretariat.
